3.	COMMUNICATION	
3.1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There is a lack of communication between Gretchen, the CPF offices and residences. This is a priority for the chair and is being dealt with. Captain Gumede is the Sector Manager and any problems or issues must be given to him who in turn takes them to his team for action. • We do not have enough support from people from different areas. We will contact Constantia Property Management, as they know all the chair people from the difference complexes in the area. Gretchen will send an e-mail to Jackie who is the director and ask her to help us, so we can communicate with people either by phone or e-mail. • It was suggested that the media attend our meetings, which they have done in the past and articles do appear in our local newspaper regarding crime etc, but the people do no respond. • Strubensvallei Resident’s Association send out newsletters and e-mails to their residents and they are getting an enormous response. • It was suggested we contact property management groups and local services like childcare, to make them aware of the crime in all areas. Charterhouse School and the Radiokop BP petrol station will distribute leaflets for us, but of course, there is cost for the printing. 4	SHEBEEN	
4.1	This shebeen is situated behind Macro on the Strubensvallei side. We have not been successful in shutting it down. The owner has now been issued with an extended license. This shebeen draws criminals and brings down the property value for the residential properties surrounding it. The police are restricted of what they can do; they will only be able to take action once someone is killed.	All

5	GREENBELT	
5.1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This greenbelt covers an area of 23 hectare. It is partly owned by two developers, one from Cape Town and Mr Morph, part by the JRA, which is better known as Metro Boulevard and a small portion by the City Parks. • The developers owning the property have been given a 15 year window in which they are unable to develop the land; due to the inability to develop they have lost interest in the land. • Captain Gumede says there are a number of vagrants on the greenbelt at Radiokop and some plastic shacks were destroyed. • One owner in Honeydew says that vagrants have moved in next to their property and the smell and the flies are atrocious. Gretchen suggested they get the Health Department to come and look. 	All
6.	LACK OF RESOURCES	
6.1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There are not enough cells at Honeydew Police Station, so prisoners have to be transferred to either Roodepoort or Randburg. • We need to fund-raise, so we can get a car for our sector, as we only have one car. • The communication between the communities and the police is very poor. We need to improve this relationship before we get cars and sponsorships. The media should be involved and interview the public and ask what goes on in the communities. The law should be changed to help the people and not the criminals. There should be a communication strategy that will help the people to sort out the problems in their areas. • The RA signboards seem to be an issue; as no government department (such as the JRA) is willing to take the responsibility to act in regards to sign board approvals.
