# Weltevreden Park welcomes Fairlands



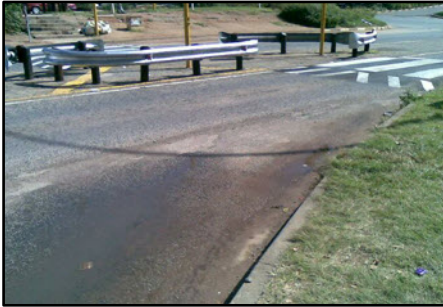
